Please note:

The “Coordinator” is our point of contact and is responsible for ensuring the rest of the group is informed on anything to do with the gardens.

All plots are provided by Wai-ora Trust on a seasonal basis with no obligation to continue offering a plot on-going to any group.

All groups must reapply each season and pay the nominated seasonal fees.

There is a one off, seasonal fee of \$100 which you can pay **on your first visit to your plot, after** we have accepted your application.

Applications can be made at any time throughout the season and will be considered with a response back within 2 weeks of your application being received.

Wai-ora Community Garden Terms of Involvement

1. I understand that our group is required to tend our plot weekly and ensure it is kept in a tidy manner.
2. I understand that our garden will be ready to access by Oct 2nd in preparation for planting at the start of October.
3. For H&S and reporting purposes I will ensure our group **signs in and out** at **EVERY** visit.
4. We will keep weeds down and maintain our plot. If our plot becomes unkempt, we understand we will be given 2 weeks to clean it up. After this time it may be forfeited back to Wai-ora. If we must abandon our plot for any reason, we will notify Wai-ora Trust immediately.
5. We understand that plots are allocated seasonally and we may have the option of applying to continue with our plot through the winter months. However, if we do not continue through winter, we will clean up and mulch our plot by 25th May 2018.
6. To ensure safety on the Wai-ora Trust property, our group will abide by all directions given by Wai-ora Trust staff pertaining to the property, implements and associated areas.
7. We agree that we will request permission in writing by Wai-ora Trust prior to media visiting the property for promotional, advertising or news coverage of any kind.
8. We will ensure all tools and implements utilized by our group will be returned to the appropriate place in the garden shed and where we are the last to leave will lock the garden shed and gate.
9. We give permission for any photos of our members which are taken in the course of our involvement in the Community Garden Plots to be used in funding applications, Wai-ora's website and media releases.
10. We agree to take photos using the Wai-ora camera which we understand will help with funding applications for this service.
11. We understand that unless agreed to, we will no longer have access to our plot as of 26th May 2018.
